Regular Fellowship

Awarded to dedicated clinicians actively fulfilling the prescribed academic, clinical, and professional evaluation criteria.

Fellowship by Distinction

Conferred upon senior physicians who have made substantial, sustained contributions to clinical medicine, research, or medical education.

Young Achiever Fellowship

Specifically designed for mid-career physicians demonstrating an exceptional clinical trajectory and outstanding promise.

Honorary Fellowship

Conferred upon eminent national or international experts in recognition of extraordinary contributions to healthcare leadership or medicine.

Gateway Prerequisites for Fellowship Eligibility

Gateway 1: Education

Recognized MBBS degree is mandatory. Preference given to postgraduates (MD, DNB, DM, Diploma) in Internal Medicine, Family Medicine, Diabetology, Endocrinology, Cardiology, or allied disciplines.

Gateway 2: Registration

Valid, active registration with the National Medical Commission (India), a State Medical Council, or another recognized statutory medical authority.

Gateway 3: Clinical Experience

Demonstrated, meaningful clinical practice in internal medicine, cardiometabolic risk, or related fields. A minimum of 5 years post-qualification experience is highly desirable.

Application Submission

Candidate submits the completed application form alongside all supporting documentation.

Preliminary Scrutiny

Initial review to ensure baseline eligibility, valid medical registration, and application completeness.

Academic Review

The Credentialing and Academic Review Committee rigorously evaluates the candidate against the 6 core domains.

Approval

Eligible and highly-rated applications are advanced to the designated academic leadership for final sign-off.

Conferment

The successful applicant is formally awarded the prestigious title: Fellow of the International Academy of Clinical and Cardiometabolic Practice (FIACCP).

An MBBS is essential. While a postgraduate qualification is not strictly mandatory, it significantly strengthens the application during the Academic Review phase.
